At our next conclave we will take some time to practice our sword drill, so we are all (including myself) doing it correctly. If any of you remember S.K. John Fletcher correcting us during inspections and other parts of the ritual, he was adamant about our sword work. His main theme and hint to properly giving cuts is that the palm of your hand must always face your opponent or fellow knight.

You should have the hand book, ASYLUM TACTICS FOR NINE MAN OPENING AND CLOSING, (if you don't you can obtain one from our recorder), where these sword movements are explained and illustrated beginning on page 25. You can practice these movements by yourself. Just remember to keep the palm of your hand towards you opponent's sword. Be ready to practice this and other tactics at the next conclave. See you there.

We will be having uniform inspection early next year. I am planning to have one of our senior S.Ks. give a presentation on uniform regulations (yes, there are uniform regulations just like the military). I have often seen blatant violations of uniform regulations. Let's look sharp in the privacy of our building so we will look sharp in public when the situation arises.
